

Measuring template for children

In order to establish the shoe size of your children please read all the instructions before you start.

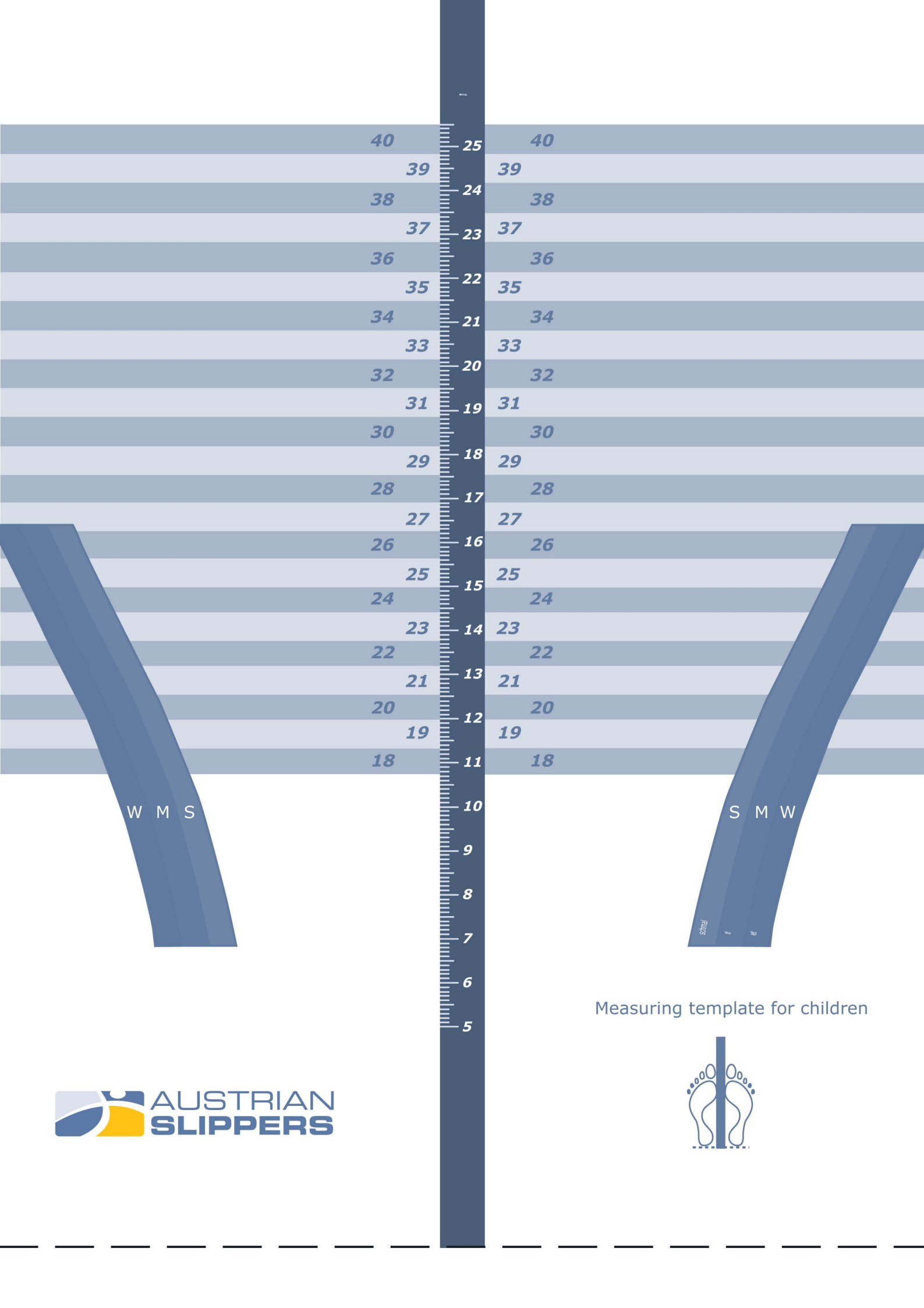
- Fold this paper now exactly along the line marked with 1 below the heel. Flatten this edge several times.
- Put the measuring template on a flat surface and with the folded edge flush to a straight wall.
- Now each foot is placed carefully and precisely on the template whereby the heel is slightly touching the wall.
- Make sure that the inner side of the feet are flush to the marked line (right and left from the measuring tape) and that the weight is equally distributed between each foot.

Important: As soon as you notice that the template has slipped you must readjust it.

- Read your shoe size (directly above the longest toe). Order exactly the size you have read because our measuring template already considers the space for rolling your foot off and the future growth of the feet. As children often curl up their toes, it is advisable that you apply slight pressure on the feet to get a correct measurement. If there is a difference between the lengths of both feet, the measurement of the larger foot will apply. If the length of the foot is between two sizes, you should always choose the larger shoe size.
- In order to determine the width of the foot, you measure the width horizontally at the ball of the foot (the broadest part of the foot) N(arrow), M(edium) or W(ide) as appropriate.
- Do not draw round the contours with a pen, as this would result in wrong measurements.

Additional information

Check the centimetre measurements of the measuring template with a ruler, as they could be distorted during printing.
